Subject: Art & Design

Theme: Frida Kahlo – Modern Art



Knowledge	Skills	Vocabulary (Top 20)
Know about the Mexican artist Frida Kahlo and recognise some of her works. Know that Frida Kahlo is not only an important figure in art history but also a symbol of strength for a diversity of communities. Understand Frida Kahlo was influenced by indigenous Mexican culture, which is apparent in her use of bright colours and dramatic symbolism. Take inspiration from the art work of Frida Kahlo to create their own art work. Make links between the work of Frida Kahlo and their own.	 On-going throughout unit of work: Use a sketchbook for a variety of purposes including: recording observations; developing ideas; testing materials; planning and recording information. Take the time to reflect upon what they like and dislike about own work and suggest how to improve it. Describe the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines and make links to own work. Lesson specific: Begin to draw in scale applying rules of simple perspective. Explore shading with various pencil grades to achieve a range of light and dark tones, black to white. Experiment with different effects and textures including blocking in colour, washes, thickened paint creating textual effects. Develop drawing faces are in proportion with increased accuracy.
