Subject: Art & Design

Theme: Michelle Reader (British Sculptor)

Know about the British sculptor Michelle Reader and recognise some of her works. Identify that Michelle Reader is known for working with recycled materials to create unique figurative sculptures. Her sculptures are often representations of people, wildlife, vehicles or landmarks. Understand that art can be created using different mediums, shape and form. Take inspiration from the artwork of Michelle Reader to create their own sculpture. Make links between the designs of Michelle Reader and their own work.	 On-going throughout unit of work: Begin to use a sketchbook to record what they see and collect and record new processes and techniques. Look at and talk about own work and that of others identifying techniques they have used. Express clear preferences and give reasons for these (e.g. I like that because). Reflect on the success of own work and identify changes they might make to develop it further. Lesson specific: Create own collage using a selection of different materials Use various collage materials to make a specific image. Shape, form, join, construct and model materials for a purpose.
