Reading at school

As a community of readers we expect all adults to model and communicate their love of reading. At Radcliffe Hall we develop this in a variety of ways:

- Daily story time
- Shared and guided reading
- Access to class and school library
- Reading with individual children





Reading at home



- Find a quiet place with no distractions.
- Sit next to them while they read showing them you are listening.
- Make predictions and talk about the book with your child before reading it.
- Allow them the opportunity to try and say a word they may be unfamiliar with.
- Read other stories at home and visit the local library where there are hundreds of children's books.

- Three game options when completing an assignment set by the teacher







Times Tables

Knowing times tables reduces the cognitive load for children as they already 'know' something (TT) so they can focus on how to apply it to different contexts (moving towards conditional knowledge)

How many areas of maths rely on TT knowledge?

- Division
- Fractions
- Factors
- Multiples
- Time
- Square and cube numbers
- Perimeter
- Area
- Measure conversions
